## The History of Switzerland Coins

In this article, I would like to share about the currency and numismatics in Switzerland, so, let us start to learn!

The official currency of Switzerland is called the Swiss franc. One Swiss franc equals 100 *rappen* (like U.S. cents). The four national languages in Switzerland are German, French, Italian and Romansh. *Rappen* is the name of the unit in German-speaking Switzerland. The same unit is called *centimes* in the part of Switzerland that has speakers of French, for *centimes* is a French word. The unit is called *centesimo* in Italian-speaking Switzerland. *Rappen* is the name preferred in the

numismatic community. As of May 2021, one Swiss franc is almost equal to 1.12 United States dollars.
