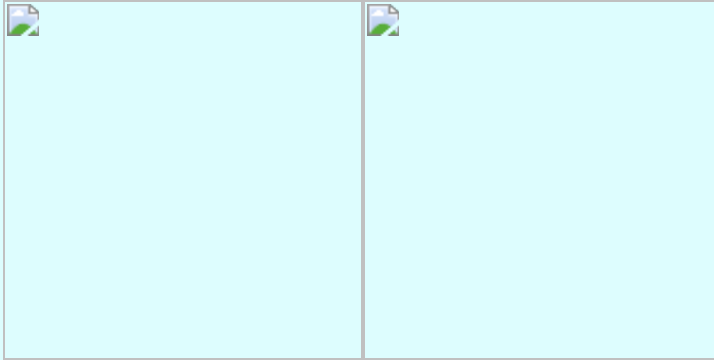

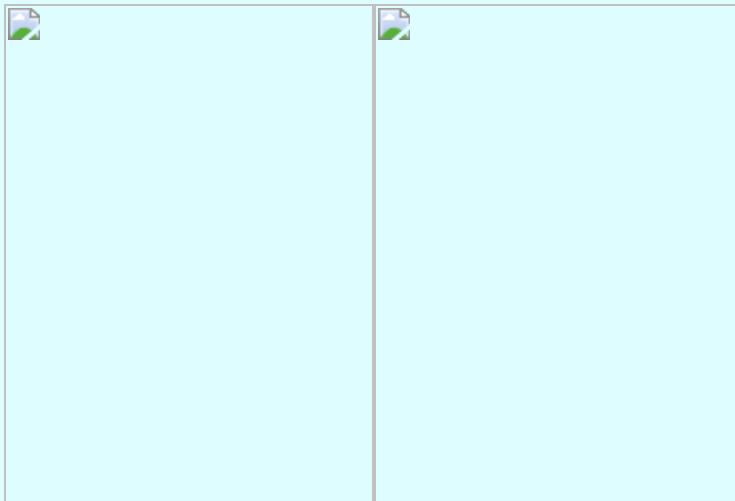

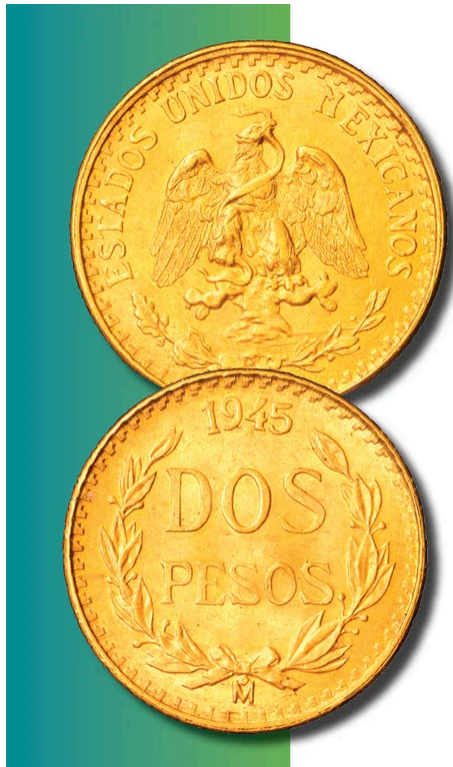
Live YN Auction Rescheduled for October 14

The 9th Annual YN Live Auction – a highlight of the year for many young collectors – has been rescheduled for October 14. **Beginning in 2023, the YN Live Auction will always take place in October.**

One of the best benefits of being an ANA YN is the opportunity to participate in the annual live online YN Auction each year. It's a wonderful learning experience that allows you to feel the excitement and yes, the pressure you'd experience bidding on items with real money (only YN Dollars are accepted in the YN Auction). Plus, you'll have the opportunity to win some real treasures! The lots consist of U.S. and world coins and currency, numismatic literature and supplies, as well as other "oddball" related items.

One hundred lots will be offered, plus ten "grab bags" at the end of the auction to provide those that did not win anything a way to obtain something fun. Bidding generally starts low but doesn't stay there for long. Many lots go for \$50-\$100, but some fetch hundreds if not thousands of dollars. It's incumbent on all participants to do their due diligence in researching the lots they are interested in to prepare for the auction.

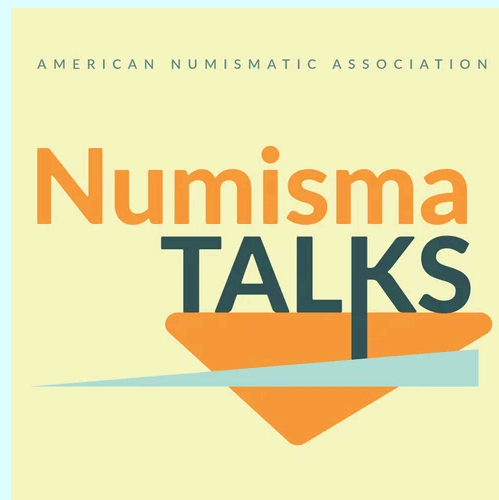

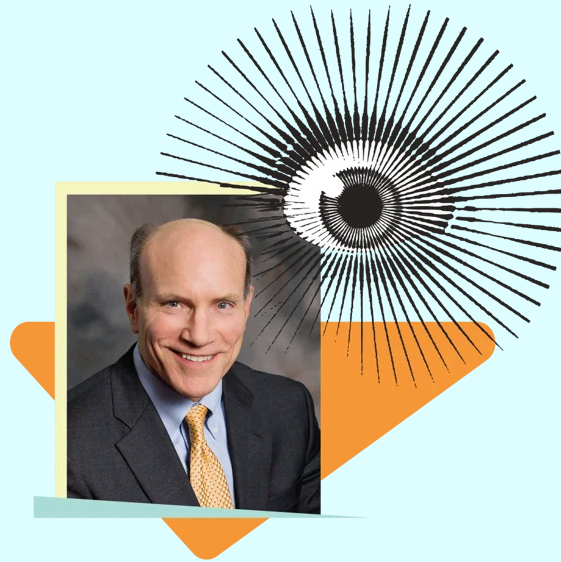
NumismaTalks presentations for September include:

"Avoiding Numismatic Nightmares: Estate and Tax Strategies When It's Time to Sell or Bequeath Your Collection"

Presented by Jeff Pritchard

This presentation addresses financial and family implications, as well as potential strategies, in transitioning away from acquiring coins, and towards their eventual distribution, in a wise and tax-efficient manner.

"Works of Art: Large Sized Silver Certificates"

Presented by Phil Vitale

The large size notes produced by the Bureau of Engraving and Printing (BEP) in the late 1800s exemplified excellence in engraving. This is especially demonstrated in the Silver Certificates produced from 1878 to 1899 which many have deemed the most beautiful notes produced by the BEP. This presentation traces the historical background of these notes and their evolution.

The class will take a look at the individual designs and the engravers that created them. There will be a short discussion on the value of those notes. Finally, Phil will talk about his collection and what's next on his radar.
